Thank you so much for your support! Mission trip 2017 was May 17-May 28 and was yet another amazing trip with many things accomplished. Thanks to extremely generous donors, since our trip last year, we have completed construction on three more homes and have started construction on two more. That is a total of nine new houses since 2014! It is so nice to know that very soon, all our families will be moved out of mud homes with dirt floors. God has so abundantly blessed our project! It was also such a blessing to have donors, Jud and Denise Pins, along on this trip to see firsthand the many ways they have made a lasting impact in the lives of our families!

On this trip, we delivered new flip flops and medical supplies to all our families. These items were donated by our local 4H group and other friends of Project Rehema. New school uniforms were also purchased for all our kids. They were so excited! Things we would consider simple and basic bring such joy to their lives.

More solar panels were installed and water lines dug and taps installed. Can you imagine not having access to water? Many women and children must walk for miles just to get water. The installation of these water lines is life changing.

I am also happy to report that our second college student, Ibra, is doing well. Thanks to our generous donors, college is a reality for him. He wants to become a teacher. Overall, our Project Rehema children are excelling in school and many rank in the top of their class!

Most of our mamas and children who have HIV are doing amazingly well. However, there is one mama who continues to struggle. She has had tuberculosis twice in the last year and almost died both times. Please continue to keep her in your prayers as well as the rest of our Rehema families. I so strongly believe in the power of prayer. God bless our donor who committed to feeding these three new HIV families that we took on last year. There is not a doubt in my mind that our intervention through this donor and our many other donors, we are saving lives. However, there is still so much work to be done.
